league in Europe. They are passionate about softball but they are small," she says.

"That would be something I would look into when I finish playing in Japan, and also developing the game in Africa.

"That might take 10 years or 20 years, but I think it's feasible to make it a true Olympic sport and then maybe the Olympic Committee will look at us differently.

After all, the Olympic Games are to softball what the World Cup is to soccer. It doesn't get any bigger.

The plight of the softballer is similar to many minor sports in Australia and the decision to exclude the sport from the Games also meant a huge drop in funding with many players forced to support their own travel when playing.

As one of the lucky ones (Roche has been playing in Japan for the past 10 years), Roche acknowledges she is privileged to be paid to play the sport she loves and the conviction in her voice tells you there is

no risk of it being taken for granted.
"I don't want to spotlight other sports and how they behave off the field, but they kind of don't respect the privilege of playing professionally. I've never taken my position as a pro athlete in Japan for granted," she said.

"(But) you have to work hard to create opportunities.

The luck I had with my career is that softball has only been in four Olympics and I was at my peak during that time. These days they don't have the Olympic stage to aim for."

As it stands, the International Softball Federation is continuing to push for the sport to be included in the 2020 Olympics with the decision due in 2013, and the game continues to power on with the Australian team contesting the World Championships in Venezuela recently.

Regardless of whether or not it regains Olympic inclusion, there is one thing guaranteed – wherever in the world Mel Roche is, she will be doing everything she can to spread the message and promote softball.

She is too thankful for what the game has given her to stand back and watch it suffer. But more importantly she cares too much about the next generation of Australian softballers to see them denied a chance at Olympic glory.
